Mornings

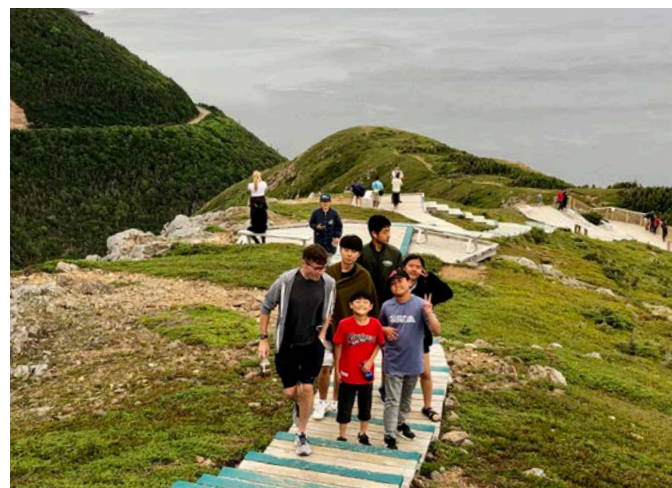

ESL CLASSES

In our morning ESL classes we will be using top-notch resources and curriculum, including:

- Cambridge Interchange - grammar, vocabulary, reading comprehension, etc.
- BrainPop - grammar, vocabulary, word games, exercises
- British Council UK - speaking, listening, comprehension exercises.
- Fable Cottage - story-telling and vocabulary.
- Explode the Code/Beyond the Code - English phonetics.
- Roald Dahl - Fantastic Mr. Fox, Beatrix Potter, Dr. Seuss, and other select pieces of English literature - for dictations, writing exercises, improving vocabulary

- Language games - i.e.: Undercover, Scategories, Taboo, Hedbanz, etc.

There will also be opportunity for students to prepare short presentations and/or debates and complete some writing exercises.

TEAM BUILDING

This will be mid morning and will include a healthy snack such as fruit and biscuits and some outdoor play. Organized games of soccer, basketball, gagaball, 4 Square, etc. If the weather is inclement, campers will play games and enjoy free play in the gym.
